

## **1 Commitment**

The overriding priority at MWH Treatment Ltd is safety. As a major infrastructure contractor, we are very aware of the risk to safety through the potential supply of Counterfeit, Fraudulent and Suspect Items (CFSI) within our supply chain.

MWH Treatment is certified to ISO 9001:2015 for 'activities including and associated with project management, design, procurement, construction and commissioning of projects; asset management and facilities management, surveying and geographic information; leakage, water and wastewater management, typically for the water sector'.

## **2 Objectives**

To mitigate risk, we only engage with suppliers who have a demonstrable capability to guarantee the quality and appropriate sourcing of the goods, materials, and services we require.

## **3 This will be achieved by**

MWH Treatment regards supply-chain co-operation as essential in maintaining the highest standards for all the goods, materials, and services we utilise within our projects, and we have robust procedures in place to manage supplier relationships. Before joining our supply chain, potential suppliers must confirm eligibility by pre-qualification through the Achilles Supplier Registration System, confirming that they have robust quality systems in place that are approved to a recognised standard. Supplier qualification is subject to continuous surveillance and audit.

## **4 Responsibilities**

Those concerned with the procurement of goods, materials and services for MWH Treatment are aware of the potential CFSI risk and will ensure that procurements are only made from properly accredited suppliers registered to MWH Treatment's supply chain.

All employees are empowered to question the veracity of supply and in cases of doubt, initiate non-conformance reporting.
