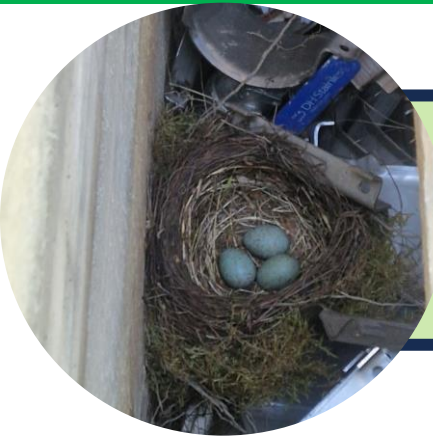


Bird nesting season is March-September. What looks like a tidy store, stockpile or a parked vehicle to us may look like an ideal nest to local wildlife. Below are some found already in 2024.

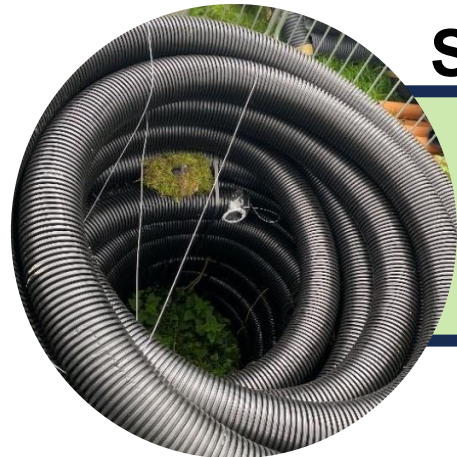


Mechanical Parts Crate: Blackbird

Discovery: Crate opened for use, nest identified and closed. Crate had not been properly closed, allowing access.

Inside Roller: Wagtail

Discovery: Plant operator observed bird activity around roller. Parked up for inspection and nest identified. Now fenced off.

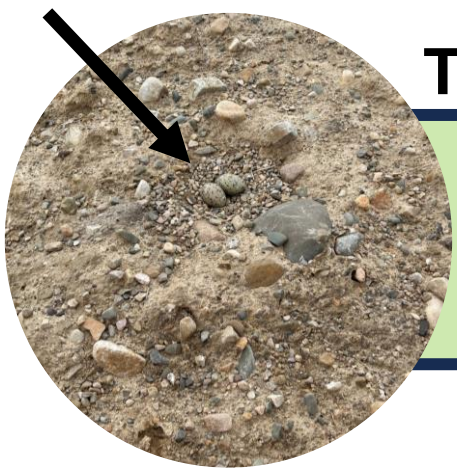


Stored Cable Ducting: Wren

Discovery: Subcontractor collecting stored materials. Isolated with Heras fencing when identified.

Inside Traffic Cone: Sparrow

Discovery: Bird observed flying in and out of the top of the traffic cone. Large clutch of eggs laid in the base.



Top of Stockpile: Oystercatcher

Discovery: Identified by Environmental Advisor on site visit. Pair of Oystercatchers seen to be guarding an area on the material stockpile.

Under MCC: Robin

Discovery: Electrical team installing cable into trays under MCC identified the nest. Works postponed in area to prevent disturbance.
