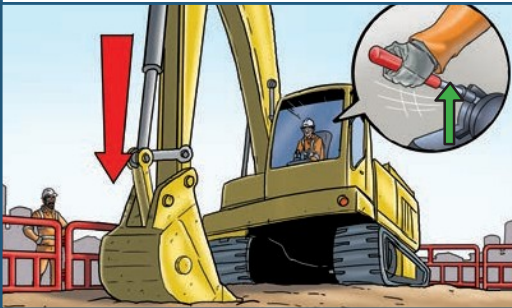


APPROACHING PLANT:

Always approach plant by their cab or visible side to catch the operator's attention.



The operator must ensure the plant is immobilised and attachments are on the ground.



Wait until the operator signals the plant is safe to approach by giving the thumbs up.



Once you have completed your business, leave the risk zone...

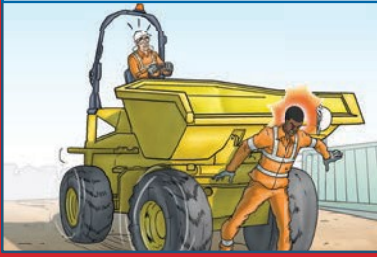


...and signal to the plant operator once you are safely out of the way and behind the barrier.

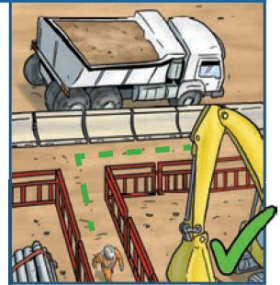
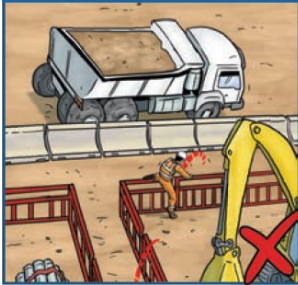


GENERAL SAFETY WHEN WORKING AROUND PLANT:

Prevent serious injury by keeping plant and pedestrians from coming into contact.



Segregate plant and pedestrians using barriers and always use designated walkways when moving around site.



Pedestrians and plant operators must obey the vehicle and traffic marshal's instructions.



Only use mobile phones in designated zones and not while operating or working near plant.



Plant operators, plant marshals, slingers and signallers must have the correct CPCs card and be familiar with the equipment they are using.
