Quality Requirements

This Theme of the Month should be briefed to support the Return to Work 2017 induction to be delivered on all MWHT projects. Following the Christmas and New Year Holiday it is essential that everyone is given sufficient time to remind themselves of their safety, health, environmental and quality responsibilities.



Inspections

All work places must be inspected before works recommence by a responsible person.

Work equipment and plant inspections to be completed prior to use.

Keep records of checks.

Slips and Trips



Surfaces may be greasy or wet, and there may be ice or frost on the compound or designated walkways.

Ladders and scaffolds may be slippery.

Ensure adequate illumination is provided for all walking routes.

RAMS

Re-brief on the RAMS and amend where necessary.

Leaks and Spills

Check chemical storage, plant nappies, drip trays, bunding and skips.

Look for signs of leaks, spillages and escape of waste.

Storage

Ensure any clean water pipework or fittings are still stored correctly off the floor.

End caps / shower caps on and have not become damaged or dirty during the break.

THINK!

Look around the work area and ask yourself or the team:

1. What could go wrong?
2. What could cause it to go wrong?
3. What can we (MWHT and YOU) do to prevent it?
