

MWH Treatment is committed to realising the highest standards of electrical safety both for our employees and others who may be affected by our activities. Our aim is therefore to meet or exceed our obligations under relevant health and safety legislation and other requirements. We have a commitment to:

- Prevent injury and death to those who may be affected by our electrical activities through the implementation of our electrical safety policy, electrical safety rules and associated procedures;
- Ensure that health and safety hazards arising from our electrical activities are adequately assessed and suitable control measures implemented to minimise the risks;
- Appoint appropriate persons to manage electrical safety at national, regional and site level;
- Allocate sufficient resources to ensure the correct application of the electrical safety policy, electrical safety rules and associated procedures;
- Effectively plan, coordinate, and manage all work activities in such a way as to avoid electrical danger;
- Provide all employees, subcontractors and others who are affected by our activities with appropriate information concerning electrical safety hazards and, where applicable, the safe systems of work to be adopted;
- Ensure only those with appropriate technical knowledge and experience, or under an appropriate level of supervision are engaged with work activities that may give rise to electrical danger;
- Ensure that all specific duty holders are aware of their responsibilities under the electrical safety rules by providing appropriate training, instruction and information;
- Provide specific duty holders with appropriate monitoring and supervision to ensure the correct implementation of and compliance with the electrical safety rules and associated procedures;
- Take appropriate action to resolve any problem areas promptly and effectively;
- Review and revise the electrical safety policy, electrical safety rules and associated procedures at suitable intervals.

We shall implement our electrical safety management activities in conjunction with our overarching health and safety management system.

Every member of staff is reminded that they have a duty of care not just for their own safety, but also for their colleagues and others, and must carry out their work in a safe and responsible manner.
