Care of the environment is central to our business. MWH Treatment is committed to sustainable development and being a responsible business. Our objective is to carry out our activities in such a manner as to minimise the effect of our activities upon the environment whilst continuing to provide value to our customers. Water is a precious resource and treated as such during MWH Treatment's activities, which is reflected within this policy statement:

**Water Protection and Pollution Prevention**

- To ensure all appropriate Permits, Consents and Licences are in place for works in, on, over waterbodies, on banks of watercourses or within floodplains. To comply with all associated conditions and requirements.
- To manage and treat groundwater and surface waters, displaced or interacted with as part of our activities, to prevent pollution and in compliance with regulatory compliance, using our Permit to Pump approach.
- To obtain abstraction licences, where necessary, for temporary groundwater pumping activities, and comply with all associated conditions and requirements.
- All fuels, oils and chemicals to be stored in secondary containment, away from waterbodies and drainage, used in accordance with COSHH Assessments.
- In the event of a pollution incident, to respond rapidly and utilise external assistance where necessary. Reporting as required to the Environmental Regulators and our clients. Lessons learnt and improvements to be acted upon and incorporated into our Integrated Management System.

**Protection of People**


- To ensure on our construction sites and offices that safety precautions, monitoring and management is in place to prevent waterborne disease, such as legionella and Weil's disease.
- To ensure Safe Systems of Work are in place for all activities with the potential to impact upon water quality and those working on our behalf.

**Engineering and Construction Activities**

- To design Treatment Works to minimise the use of potable water, maximise recirculation and recycling, minimise chemical usage and improve on energy efficiency.
- To optimise treatment and chemical usage to achieve Regulator discharge requirements.
- To comply with all drinking water legislation and client requirements.
- To reduce use of potable water through reuse and utilising grey water or final effluent where possible.
- To monitor potable water use in offices and construction sites to identify savings.

**Management are responsible for ensuring that this policy is understood at all levels of the Company and that effective management systems are implemented.**

**Every employee shall play an active part in supporting MWH Treatment in implementing this policy so that we remain responsible for our actions.**
